According to Kelly (2021), First and foremost, among the new leaders of the home school movement was Michael Ferris, a home school parent and lawyer, founded the Home School Legal Defense Association (HSLDA) in 1983, until the adoption rules are mandatory for schools in the United States beginning in the mid-19th

For example, in the United States, Adolf Burley, a professor at Tufts University in Medford, Massachusetts, wrote the *School in the home*. 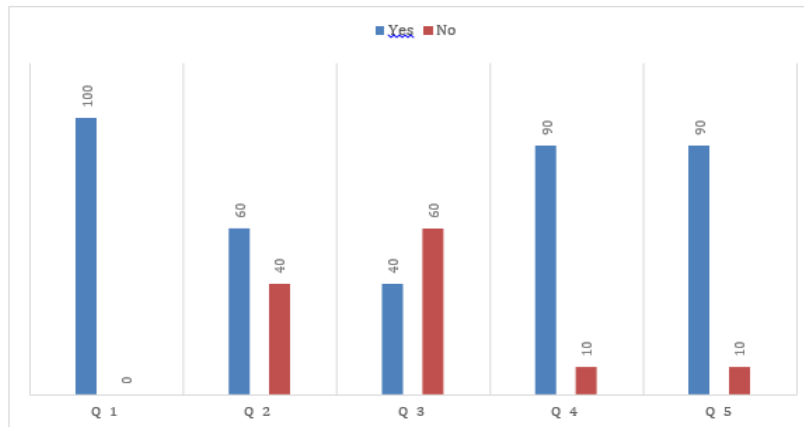

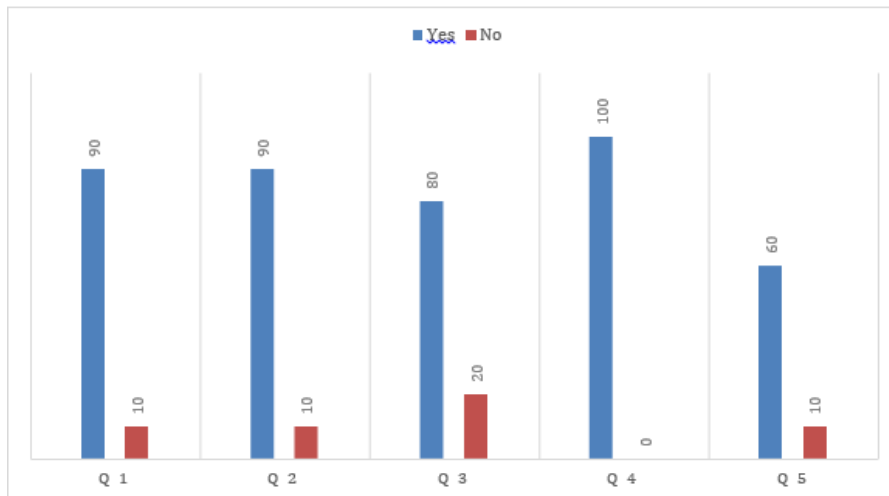
Findings

80% students say “Yes” and 20% say “No”, so majority of students say their teacher gives equal chance to participate in different educational activities

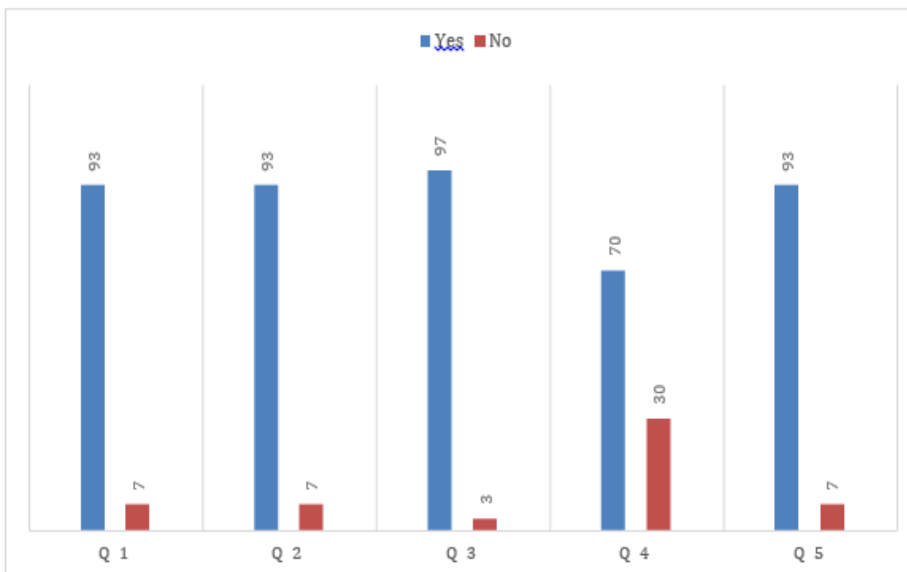
7. Parent appreciate them when they show good performance in the school?
